Report A total of fifteen hikers left the North Dominga Baca Multigenerational Center (NDBMC) in a van and two autos. Another three hikers met us at the trail head at the south end of Corrales. After introductions, we started the hike at approximately 8:30. It was a beautiful day for hiking with temperatures ranging from the mid thirties to the mid forties, very little wind, and clear blue skies.

The first half of the hike was along the Corrales Riverside Drain. This is a straight level hiking section with large houses on one side and the Bosque on the other side. We saw numerous Mallard ducks swimming in the drain, a large group of Sandhill cranes flying above us, and a Blue Herron perched in a large Cottonwood tree as we hiked along the Riverside Drain.

At the hike half way point we crossed over into the Bosque for the remainder of the hike back to the van.

We returned to the van at 10:30 and back to the center before 11:00 AM.
